"I consider myself a realist in my everyday life and in turn I strive for my work to reflect this philosophy. Through my representational paintings I hope to convey a sense of peace and clarity. The goal for my work is to engage the viewer so that they might see the beauty in a common subject in a way that is not familiar to them. Painting with oils gives me the freedom and ability to layer coat upon coat, building up the subject until it pops off
